Keeping You Informed

Everyone should have received in their 'mailbox' Project RACK outreach effort of expressing God's Love in Action through the distribution of prayer cards. It is our prayer these special cards, picked especially for you, encourage & uplift you in your daily walk! If for some reason, you didn't receive your prayer cards, please let us know in the church office.

We adopted the proposed MBC Financial Policies in the Annual Church Conference on Sept 23rd. We want to thank Teresa Page & our Finance Committee for their excellent work.

The Planning Board unanimously granted our request for a 'text amendment' to the Yadkinville Sign Ordinance. The next step is for a 'public hearing' to be scheduled for Nov 2nd, at which time, any concerns can be addressed and the Town Board will vote on this 'text amendment'. We anticipate it will be approved and we'd 'vote by ballot', on our proposed LED sign, on Sunday - Nov 15th; as well as, you'd have the opportunity to stop by MBC (Nov 16th & 17th) and cast your ballot.

We've made a request to the YBA Ordination Council to 'examine' Curtis Carmack for the purpose of ordaining him to the Gospel Ministry. They will meet with Curtis on Sat (Oct 10th) along with Clay Overby, Mickey Keasler, HL Wooten & Pastor Jimmy.

We're exploring the possibility of our Bible Fellowship for Life groups beginning to 'regather' in-person on Sunday - Dec 6th. In some cases, classes may be 're-assigned' to a different room - so as to create proper safety protocols.

We'll begin to resume 'in-person' Prayer & Bible Study on Wednesday (Nov 4th) at 6:30 pm in the Fellowship Bldg. If you have a topic for study of interest - pass along your ideas to Jimmy.
